



Yeats Summer School Stipend Application Guidelines 2021

Who can apply?

The Yeats Summer School Stipend is open to Bachelor and Master students of English who are enrolled at a Swiss university at the time of application.

How to apply?

Applicants must submit the following documents, in one single PDF file:

- application form (available at www.es.uzh.ch/yeats);
- one- to two-page motivation letter (Why would you like to attend the Yeats Summer School in Sligo? What makes you a good candidate?);
- two one-page letters of recommendation (at least one of which should be from a university-level instructor of English);
- copy of the latest university transcript (i.e. Fall Semester 2020);
- a 1000-word ($\pm 10\%$) close critical analysis of a text by Yeats (e.g. a short poem, one-act play, or excerpt from a longer play or poem).

Applicants may submit up to two pages of additional information, if they wish.

Contact and deadlines:

- Applications must be submitted by May 31, 2021. (Note The Yeats Summer School is scheduled to take place from July 28–August 6, 2021.)
