Regulations for the Lehrdiplom: Main Points

Lehrdiplom candidates must complete a six-month stay abroad (i.e. 26 weeks – i.e. 182 days – with max. one interruption) **before** being allowed to book the module *Fachdidaktik I.*

Criteria for Stays Abroad

The stay abroad must take place after the *Matura*, in a region in which English is the first language of a majority of inhabitants. This requirement can be waived if:

- the candidate spent a full academic year at an English-language school in a predominantly English-speaking region after the age of 15 (e.g. at a US high school);
- one's entire schooling until at least the age of 12 took place in English-language schools in predominantly English-speaking regions.

Students are expected to **be able to submit written proof** of their stay abroad (e.g. flight tickets, certificates of enrollment and/or employment, etc.). **Note:** Flight tickets alone do not constitute proof!



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SEMP (Replacement for Erasmus+)

Aim

to promote student mobility and cooperation between European universities

Conditions

- enrolled at UZH when applying and during exchange
- min. 2 semesters at UZH completed before leaving for exchange
- Learning Agreement (UZH IRO)
- Anerkennungsvereinbarung (ES \rightarrow Studiendekanat)

English Department + UZH Places

- via Mobility Online (3 preferred choices)
- if applying to both:
 - follow both guidelines
 - the earlier deadline counts (i.e. Dec 1)

ISEP Places

- via ISEP link (7 preferred choices)

- Note: better conditions than previously
- But: will be discontinued in c. 2020/21
- some universities: quality a bit lower

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Anerkennungsvereinbarung (ES / Studiendekanat)

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Accreditation

- no accreditation without prior Anrechnungsvereinbarung!
- compulsory courses should be done at ES and not abroad
 → exception: obtain written confirmation before departure
- in many cases: credit points from abroad must be converted
 - → cf. "Guidelines for Accreditation of Courses from Other Universities" at <u>www.es.uzh.ch/studies/Downloads.html</u>
- upon return: submit original transcripts & all written work to: Martin Mühlheim (studyabroad@es.uzh.ch)

Entry Requirements

- be between the required ages of 21 and 29
- have completed 4 semesters of undergrad studies related to education prior to start
- be currently enrolled OR have graduated no more than 12 months before the start
- have a career goal in education
- proficiency in English and enthusiastic about sharing their culture and native language

Interns:

- are assigned to a supervising teacher
- work in school for approximately 32 hours a week (excludes occasional special events)
- play a flexible role in the classroom (e.g. assisting teacher, developing materials, etc.)

Note: Interns stay with a host family (free room and board) + monthly stipend of \$200





Teaching Abroad (II) – UK: Movetia cf. https://www.movetia.ch

Who can take part?

- Swiss students, graduates or teachers with no professional experience (or experience of max. 3 years)
- native speakers of French or German (no places in the UK for native speakers of Italian)
- min. 4 semesters at university, university of applied arts & sciences or a teacher training college.
- between 21 and 30 years of age (in some cases, up to 35 years)

Note: Currently only UK. (Ireland being explored - details will be announced in mid-December.)

Where and how to apply?

- processing fee of CHF 150.- is charged by Movetia on definite admission into the programme.

Salary

The language assistants are paid a monthly salary, which varies depending on the host country.
