- agree to stay in programme for (usually) 2 semesters

## Accreditation

- no accreditation without prior Anrechnungsvereinbarung!
- compulsory courses should be done at ES and not abroad
   → exception: obtain written confirmation before departure
- in many cases: credit points from abroad must be converted
   → cf. "Guidelines for Accreditation of Courses from Other Universities" at www.es.uzh.ch/teaching/Downloads.html
- upon return: submit original transcipts & all written work to: Martin Mühlheim (studyabroad@es.uzh.ch)
