- agree to stay in programme for (usually) 2 semesters
- Learning Agreement (UZH IRO)

Accreditation

 - **exception:** *obtain written confirmation before departure*
- in many cases: credit points from abroad must be converted

- upon return: submit original transcripts & all written work to:
