

Syeda Kashmala is an award-winning film producer known for her strong record of public engagement through films such as Natari, The Losing Side, and Craft Traditions of Pakistan.

Natari tells the story of the conflict caused by climate migration and its impact on local communities and families such as that of fisherman and political activist Ayoub Sehto in the Indus Delta region.


