The three papers that every regular student has to and every other student may deliver are to be written in English. They must be sent to lst.babusiaux@rwi.uzh.ch until Thursday morning 6 a.m. (in PDF and docx. format for the verifying word count). Papers that arrive later shall not be taken into

account.

Please label your documents as «CPL_last name first name_matriculation number_Paper 1.pdf/docx» for 1st paper and «CPL_last name first name_matriculation number_Paper 2.pdf/docx» for the 2nd paper and so forth. As for the subject line of your email, please use «CPL Paper Nr. 1» for the 1st paper and «CPL Paper Nr. 2» for the 2nd paper and so forth.

Formal requirements:

1. The papers must not exceed **2'500 words** (incl. spaces and footnotes). The number of words has to be indicated at the end of the paper. The paper must present a clear structure and sub-titles (no more than two levels according to the scheme: A/B/C, then 1/2/3). A separate bibliography is not necessary but gives a full indication of any reference the first time you reference the scheme.

2. The papers must meet academic requirements as to the originality of thinking, proofs in footnotes and the use of bibliography. Every paper must contain the personal data of the student, including a postal and an e-mail-address as well as a "Eigenständigkeitserklärung" (declaration of originality) duly signed. Papers that do not contain this declaration and the

signature shall not be corrected.

Requirements as to content:

The topics to be treated differ from one week to another and depend on the topic of the compulsory reading.

The relevant topic of every week will be published after the forgoing meeting <u>on/until Thursday</u> evening here.

Attention: The first topic will be published on September 29th (for the October 6th) and the last possibility to write a paper will be for the meeting of November 24th (meaning that the topic will be published on November 17th).

Please note: It is up to the students to plan their delivery of the required number of papers throughout the semester!
